DISCIPLESHIP PLAN

The Personal Discipleship Plan will outline your "Spaces", "Solutions" and "Service". This will be given to you shortly after your Pastoral Meeting.

FLOURISH

This Plan is only as good as you living out the good works the Lord has prepared beforehand for you to do.

Review your plan and prioritize it within your schedule as soon as possible.

PASTORAL MEETING

At your Pastoral Meeting you will review your Spiritual Inventory with your Pastor and put together a Personal Discipleship Plan. This meeting may be by yourself or with your spouse.

THE FIVE SPACES OF DISCIPLESHIP

Discipleship at Cornerstone happens in five spaces: Sunday Worship, Abide, Personal Discipleship, Growth Groups, and Flourish Fellowships. The following sections provide a description of what each space is, as well as corresponding questions. These questions will help you assess your current involvement in these five spaces of discipleship while helping you discover new ways you might like to grow in the upcoming year.



THE "SUNDAY WORSHIP" SPACE

The "Sunday Worship" space refers to our gathering as God's people on Sundays to worship Him through prayer, singing, giving, preaching, and communion. Whether at the 8:30am or 10:30am service, this weekly space affords us the opportunity to glorify God and grow in Christ. As we engage in corporate worship reverently, thoughtfully, and prayerfully we are personally challenged, convicted, comforted, and encouraged.

These groups offer helpful accountability in the Christian life and provide you with opportunities to enjoy gospel-centered community with others from Cornerstone.

THE "SUNDAY WORSHIP" SPACE

- Typical Sunday: (1) ABF/Flourish Together at 8:30am, (2) Worship Service at 10:30am, & (3) Serving as an usher. This is a good balance for now. How Sundays look will be re-evaluated with the new baby arriving in September.
- Start praying on Saturday before bed, asking the Lord to prepare his heart for worship/rest/fellowship.



THE "ABIDE" SPACE

- Begin the "Abide" reading plan in July. Be sure to get bookmarks.
- Until the "Discipleship Toolbox" is taught, begin improving journaling by the S.O.A.P method.
- Grow in the discipline of memorizing Scripture by (1) memorizing the one verse you write down daily in your journal or (2) by using the FighterVerse app (Pastor Rick will share the app).



THE "PERSONAL DISCIPLESHIP" SPACE

- Reach out to Jerod Birchell to see if he can disciple you. Connect with Pastor Rick if he is unavailable to meet.



THE "GROWTH GROUP" SPACE

- In September, re-evaluate your schedule for GGs & Flourish Fellowships (keep Kristy and baby in mind).
- With his first baby on the way, Chris is excited about the idea of a possible Parenting GG here at CCC.
- Optional: get in the Men's GG if Parenting GG is delayed.



THE "FLOURISH FELLOWSHIPS" SPACE

- In September, re-evaluate your schedule for GGs & Flourish Fellowships (keep Kristy and baby in mind).
- Keep preparing for "ABF/Flourish Together" by reading the current chapter on Saturday nights. Consider stepping back for a bit in the autumn.
- Attend Wednesday PM Men's Flourish (may alternate with Kristy week by week)

SOLUTIONS (Answers/Next Steps)

- **Prepare your heart to usher with joy at CCC** — We briefly reviewed Mark 10:45 together. Chris will continue to meditate on it: "For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Our aim is to not forget Christ, who served us. Reflect on this. Pray for humility and help. Prepare for ushering ministry on Saturday nights by praying for names via the church directory.
- **Talking with Unbelievers** — Keep praying for his co-worker Kyle, looking for an open door to share his testimony and the hope we have in Christ (1 Peter 3:15, noted "gentleness and respect").
- **Calvinism vs. Arminianism** — This is a common, often contentious, issue for many Christians. We want to hold our convictions firmly and humbly. Pastor Rick mentioned some key passages (Isaiah 45, Romans 9, Jude 20-25), shared a few book and sermon recommendations, and will be emailing an article to help mature understanding of this significant, non-salvific doctrine.
- **Working unto the glory of God** — What does this look like practically? Connect with your Elder/EIT (Steve Glancey) to schedule a coffee and unpack this further.

SERVICE (Serving the body through...)

- **Ushering Ministry** — you're going to talk with Scott Cox about being his "official" backup when he is out of town
- **AV** — Talk with Jon Hayter about getting trained as a backup in the AV Ministry after new baby is 6+ months old
